



DSTHL Roster Rules

(These Rules are incorporated into the DSTHL Policies, Game Rules,
and Procedures by reference therein)

July 2016

All Players and Team Officials must be USA Hockey (USAH) registered at the appropriate level.

Association Registrars

Association Registrars are responsible for submitting **1-Ts and Supplementals** to the appropriate USAH Registrar (Bettepat, Jill, or Anne) for **date stamp and signature – then submit to the Dallas Stars Travel Hockey League Registrar** (DSTHL-Tanya) with **supporting documentation for stamped league approval**. **Associations registrars are then responsible for forwarding all league stamped/approved 1-T's to respective team managers**. In addition, Association registrars are responsible for verifying all his/her Member Association's **coach credentials and certifications (CEP #'s/renewal and module completion)** and supplying validation to the **League Registrar** for confirmation.

League Rosters

- A Player may only be rostered on one (1) League team at any time (as set forth in the DSTHL Policies, Game Rules, and Procedures) except for League-approved emergency goalie situations.
- All players must be rostered in their respective age divisions. Squirt players on squirt teams, PeeWee players on peewee teams, Bantam players on bantam teams, Midget Minor players on Midget Minor teams and Midget Major players on Midget Major teams. Any exceptions must be DSTHL board approved.
- Use of emergency goalies must be approved by the League before they may play in any League games.

- As of December 31st of each calendar year, League rosters are frozen and final with the following exceptions:
- (a) In the event of a season-ending event to a goalie; provided, however, that team has only one (1) rostered goalie.
- (b) Team Official additions will be permitted at any time during regular season play with League and USAH approval.
- Team Official alterations and emergency goalies situations will be reviewed and approved by the League on a case-by-case basis.
- **League rosters may not deviate from and must match 1-Ts and Supplementals.**
- **If your team attends any tournaments during the DSTHL season, please create a separate 1-T and label it “Tournament”.**

League Roster Changes

- The only person from any Member Association that will be authorized to request roster changes is the **Association Registrar.**
- All League roster changes/requests are to be made by the **Association Registrar** to the **League Registrar.**
- Allow up to **seventy-two (72) hours** for a Player move/change to become effective in Pointstreak. Normally does not that amount of time but it is possible. Basically, in order for a change to be considered for weekend play, all documents and approved 1-T must be to league registrar by Thursday of that week. No changes made on game day, except for emergency goalie issues. (per league rules)
- **Players that are added to the 1-T Roster are not automatically added to the League (DSTHL) roster.**
- **It is the responsibility of the Association Registrar to provide copies of all signed 1-Ts and Supplementals to the League Registrar as any roster changes transpire.**

Responsibilities of the Association Registrar for Roster Changes

Send an email (**written**) request to **League Registrar** including the following:

- Name of the team EXACTLY as it is shown in Pointstreak.
- Name of the Player or Team Official involved.
- Release/Transfer **documents** (if applicable) as designated herein.
- Designation of **jersey number** to be worn (if applicable).

- **Player status** with regards to skater/goaltender.
- The USAH-approved **(signed by USAH Registrar) 1-T or Supplemental**.

It is the **Association Registrar's responsibility** to see that the **League Registrar** gets **copies of all documents in order for League changes to be effective**.

All of these items must be submitted to, validated by, AND approved by the **League Registrar** in accordance with herein-established requirements before the League roster is changed. Once approved by league registrar the 1-T will be stamped and dated and returned to the association registrar by email. **It is then the responsibility of the association registrar to send the league approved 1-T to the appropriate team manager. This is proof that the player(s)/coach(es) listed is approved for league play. 1-T's/changes are not approved by league until a LEAGUE stamped 1-T has been returned to the association registrar.**

Player Release/Transfer

Players may not transfer from one organization to another organization without a written Release from the organization the Player is leaving. Players will not be considered legally rostered on the new team's League roster until the following has transpired:

- Player is released by original team.
- Player is added to new team via USAH 1-T Supplemental **(Note: adding a Player to your USAH 1-T does NOT automatically add them to the DSTHL roster. This is a separate transaction and must be done through the League Registrar.)**
- Player is deleted from original team's League roster.
- Player is added to new team's League roster.

Player Adds / Drops

No Player may be added to Pointstreak at game time or by an Association Pointstreak Point of Contact; ONLY the League Registrar may add players to League Rosters in Pointstreak in accordance with the above guidelines. The addition of Player(s) at game time or by an Association Pointstreak Point of Contact will result in further action by the League.

Drops – Detailed email (including reason for removal) should be sent to **League Registrar** when player is removed from team. A **signed supplement** should be attached showing player has been dropped from the roster.

Team Managers should submit their changes to their Association Registrar, who will request roster changes and send proper documentation to the League Registrar. Approved changes will be returned to the association registrar who MUST send the league approved 1-T to the appropriate team manager. This is proof that the player(s)/coach(es) listed is approved for league play. 1-T's/changes are not approved by league until a "LEAGUE stamped 1-T" has been returned to the association registrar.

Use Of Ineligible Player or Coach

The use of an ineligible player or coach in a DSTHL game(s) will automatically result in a forfeit of that game(s) and be subject to additional discipline as determined by the DSTHL Executive Board.

Minimum Roster

At any time a roster drops below the established Player minimum, the roster will be reviewed by the League and may result in further action by the League.

Other

All other League rules apply as outlined in the **DSTHL Policies, Game Rules, and Procedures.**
