
BRANDON ESCOTO NAMED MASL JANUARY PLAYER OF THE MONTH


SOCKERS ON A WORLD STAGE

Before Landon Donovan, a bounty of world class superstar players plied their trade with the Sockers.

Kaz Deyna led Poland to the gold medal in the 1972 Olympics in Munich, where he was the Top Goalscorer, with 9 goals. Then he led Poland to the bronze in World Cup 1974. At the 1976 Montreal Olympics his team reached the finals yet again and won the silver medal. He Captained Poland at the World Cup in Argentina in 1978. He was ranked third in the European Footballer of the Year for 1974, behind Johan Cruyff and Franz Beckenbauer.



Hugo Sanchez, played two seasons for the Sockers early in his career. A prolific goalscorer known for his spectacular strikes and volleys, Hugo Sanchez is widely regarded as the greatest Mexican footballer of all time, representing Mexico in 3 different World Cups. With famed Real Madrid, Sanchez won five consecutive league titles from 1985 to 1990, a Copa del Rey title in 1989 and the UEFA Cup in 1986. During those five years, Sanchez won four-consecutive Pichichi trophies as La Liga's leading scorer. He scored 27 or more goals in four consecutive seasons.
